## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

## Cat Trap Hire

Quilpie Shire Council provides cat traps on loan to residents as a service to the community.

To hire a cat trap there is a deposit required in the amount of \$30 per trap.

To obtain refund you must return the trap within 4 weeks of the hire date. The cage must be returned fully cleaned and undamaged.

If the cat trap is not returned by the end of the 4 week period, then you will not be refunded \$30.

If the trap is needed for a longer period of time, Quilpie Shire Council must be notified before the date the hire period ends.

## **When Trapping Cats**

- Check to determine if the cat you have trapped is an identified cat, identification includes:
  - o A cat is wearing a collar with an address or telephone number of the owner.
  - A cat that is micro chipped will have the letter "M" tattooed inside one of its ears. All other tattoos mean the cat has been spayed.
- It is an offence to trap an identified cat and the animal must be returned to the place where it was trapped.
- Traps must be inspected daily to prevent suffering.
- Do not enter property unlawfully to trap a cat.
- When a cat has been caught in a trap you must immediately contact Quilpie Shire Council on 4656 0500.
