• **NO CHILDREN Will Be Permitted In The Library Until Further Restrictions Are Lifted**

• Please Do Not Enter If You Are Feeling Unwell or Have a Temperature

• **Maximum Duration of Visit – 1 Hour**

• Social Distancing of 1.5 Metres Must Be Adhered to

• Maximum Of **10 People** In The Library At Any One Time

• Only **1 Person** Permitted In The Centrelink Self Access Booth At Any One Time

• Public Access Computers - 2 Available By Request, Maximum 1 Hour
